### **Please Note: Proper Targets and Proper Target Attachment**

The **only allowable targets** for use on any range at Mount Joy Sportsman's Association are **paper targets**. No bottles, cans, or other non-paper targets. The only exceptions are the 3D archery targets and the clay shotgun targets. Targets must be properly attached to the backstops when shooting. **DO NOT** place targets so that the shots pierce the wood frames. Wood frames are costly and time consuming to repair. **PLEASE** help to keep your club neat and use care not to cause unnecessary damage.
